who being duly sworn and having heard the evidence, argument of counsel and charge of the Court say that they find the issues in favor of the Plaintiff and found that the Plaintiff had proved by ~~clear and convincing~~ ^{a preponderance of the ^{AW}} evidence that the Defendant is liable to the Plaintiff a sum of money relative to intentional sexual battery of the Plaintiff. Accordingly, the jury, as finders of fact, assessed her compensatory damages at the sum of \$300,000.00 and indicated that punitive damages were

which the jury found to have been proven by clear and convincing evidence


warranted based on the Defendant's egregious and intentional conduct. Additionally, after a bifurcated hearing for the purpose of determining such punitive damages, and after having heard argument on the issue of punitive damages, the jury said they find the issues in favor of the Plaintiff by clear and convincing evidence and assessed her punitive damages at the sum of \$225,000.00. Furthermore, the Defendant was previously ordered to pay Plaintiff's counsel \$752.50 as a sanction for failing to cooperate with the discovery process pursuant to this Court's Order of January 22, 2014.

In accordance therewith it is ORDERED, ADJUGED and DECREED that the Plaintiff, Nicole Collins recover of the Defendant, Harold Limburg, the sum of \$525,752.50 with interest at the legal rate and her cost of this action, for all of which execution may issue.
